

MSA Manor Update

January 14th, 2022



Dear Residents and Families of MSA Manor

We are writing to follow up on the email that was sent out earlier this week.

At this time:

- We tested the residents identified as having possible exposure, and three residents have come back positive for COVID -19. These three residents are currently asymptomatic and doing well. Their families have been notified.
- We have 2 positive staff members, and they are isolating at home
- Residents and staff are being screened twice daily for any signs of illness
- Residents have been cohorted into separate dining areas
- Those who develop symptoms will be isolated, tested for COVID-19 and provided the care they need
- We will continue to be diligent with our infection control practices
- We will keep you up to date on any changes related to your family member's health status

Following the new Fraser Health guidelines and recommendations, when a site has identified Residents, we will be on enhanced monitoring and continue to restrict our visiting to essential visitors only. We will be reviewing this again next week. You will be contacted if you had a designated visit booked to reschedule.

Again, we do appreciate your understanding and patience, given the rapid spread of the Omicron variant that is currently happening in BC. We will continue to update you through this email if there are further developments.
