Dear Families of Residents at Maplewood House,

As part of our site renovations, painting will commence in the resident wings starting Thursday January 25th. The paints are non-toxic and fumeless. Bluebell wing will be the first to be painted, followed by Rosewood, and then Shamrock.

Please be aware that while stretches of hallways are being painted, work areas will be cordoned off, and affected residents will be moved outside of their rooms from 9AM to 6PM (with limited access to their rooms). Each resident can expect this to occur for 2-3 days max while their stretch of the hallway is being completed. Our recreation and care staff will ensure that while residents are out of their rooms during the day, all their activity and care needs are fully addressed.

Those with specific care needs who cannot be outside their rooms for long periods of time will continue to have full access to their rooms, with assistance from staff. As an added layer of safety and precaution, we will schedule additional staff to be assigned to the painting areas to monitor and assist residents as needed.
