



Maplewood House Update

Dear Residents and Families of Maplewood House

We are writing to notify you that Maplewood House has moved to enhanced monitoring as we have had several Residents that have shown symptoms and tested positive for COVID 19. We will be working with Fraser Health and medical staff to take steps to protect the health of all residents and staff. Please be reassured that we have spoken to the designated family member / contact person for any resident that has tested positive.

At this time:

- Residents and staff are being screened twice daily for any signs of illness
- Any Residents who develop symptoms will be isolated, tested for COVID-19 and provided the care they need in their rooms
- Residents who test positive will be supported in their rooms for five days or until their symptoms improve
- We will continue to be diligent with our infection control practices
- We will keep you up to date on any changes related to your family member's health status
- Residents have been cohorted and are in separate dining areas for meals as much as possible
- Group activities have been put on hold until further notice
- Visitors are still welcome following usual screening and rapid PCR test
 - Please continue to visit in Residents room only
 - Please continue to wear your mask at all times and do frequent hand hygiene

We appreciate your understanding and patience, given the rapid spread of the Omicron variant that is currently happening in BC again. When we have more information, we will update you through this email. Thank you and stay safe.
